## RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PRESCHOOL PROGRAM WILL RESUME IN OCTOBER

Our Seeds of Faith Program is a program designed for all four and five year olds, and it takes place during the 9:00 AM Mass every Sunday.

Children are taught by two trained adult catechists assisted by youth volunteers. The children gather for the Entrance Procession and participate in the Opening Rites of the Mass. They will be called up to the front of the Church for a blessing and then sent to hear God's Word proclaimed in a nearby classroom. The children will experience the Sunday Gospel at their level of understanding through stories, activities and song. They will discover their special place in a friendly, caring environment, where the presence of Jesus is felt. Following this Lectionary-based catechesis they will return to the Mass for the Blessing and Dismissal. Reunited with their families all will be sent to "Go in Peace to Love and Serve the Lord and One Another".
